PARKING: All vehicles parked at Whiskeytown are required to display a valid entrance pass on the driver's side of the dashboard. Permits are available at the Whiskeytown Visitor Center during opening hours (credit cards only). It is recommended that you purchase your pass in advance online at <https://www.recreation.gov/sitepass/74295>. This is required in addition to camping passes.

SOCIAL: A catered dinner will be served at Regatta Headquarters at 1800 hours on Saturday May 23rd. **Pre-registration and payment for dinner is required by Monday, May 18th.** We hope you will stay and enjoy great company and LIVE MUSIC!

CAMPING AT BRANDY CREEK MARINA: Self-contained RV camping is allowed in the designated areas in the South End of the Brandy Creek Marina Parking Lot. [RV camping fees will be paid to the Whiskeytown Sailing Club in advance of your stay.](#) There is no longer a pay-by-envelope system. **NO TENTS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BRANDY CREEK PARKING LOT CAMPING AREAS.** Our space is limited by our National Park Service Permit, and due to the increased popularity, your cooperation is appreciated as we try to make space for all who would like to enjoy camping at the lake. Our permit allows for arrival Wednesday May 20th and checkout on Monday May 25th.

Oak Bottom Marina: Individual tent campsites and RV parking is available by reservation at Oak Bottom Marina: 530-359-2008.

Zebra Mussels: Whiskeytown National Recreation Area requires all boats that enter Whiskeytown Lake complete an inspection prior to launching. This can be done at the Visitor's Center or at the Brandy Creek Marina (on a schedule to be announced). Review the Self Certification form that is available during registration and on our web site www.whiskeytownsailing.org. Follow the directions and display the certification page in your windshield. This is required even if you have the CA DMV sticker. To ensure that boats traveling around the State are safe, visit <https://www.nps.gov/whis/learn/nature/nonnatives.htm>
