**PARKING:** All vehicles parked at Whiskeytown are required to display a valid entrance pass on the driver's side of the dashboard. Permits are available at the Whiskeytown Visitor Center during opening hours (limited hours due to COVID, credit cards only). It is recommended that you purchase your pass in advance online at <https://www.nps.gov/whis/planyourvisit/fees.htm> . This is required in addition to camping passes.

**SOCIAL:** A catered dinner will be served at Regatta Headquarters at 1800 hours on Saturday May 28. **Pre-registration and payment for dinner is required by Tuesday, May 24th.**

**CAMPING AT BRANDY CREEK MARINA:** Self-contained RV camping is allowed in the designated areas in the South End of the Brandy Creek Marina for \$20 per night per vehicle or \$10 for Senior/Access passholders. RV camping fees will be paid to the Whiskeytown Sailing Club in advance of your stay. There is no longer a pay-by-envelope system. **NO TENTS ARE ALLOWED IN THE BRANDY CREEK RV CAMPING AREAS.** Our space is limited by our National Park Service Permit, and due to the increased popularity, your cooperation is appreciated as we try to make space for all who would like to enjoy camping at the lake. Our permit allows for arrival Thursday May 26<sup>th</sup> and checkout on Monday May 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Oak Bottom Marina:** Individual tent campsites and RV parking is available by reservation at Oak Bottom Marina: 530-359-2008.

**Zebra Mussels:** Whiskeytown National Recreation Area requires all boats that enter Whiskeytown Lake complete the Self Certification form.
